

Application Process

- Priorities are set using Vital Signs + Vital Update
- Applications open 3 May, close 10 June
- Visits by Distributions committee July
- Decision made mid-August
- Payment early September



Useful Things To Consider

- Applications for general operating costs welcome
- 2/3 of funds are "tagged" by donors
- Read priority areas carefully
- Provide all information asked for
- Current maximum is \$10,000
