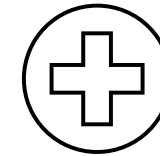

## How does the Aotearoa New Zealand COVID Pass work?

The pass uses digital technologies to give the person checking your pass the confidence that it's valid and not manipulated.

When someone checks your pass, they will scan the QR code with the Ministry of Health Verify App. The app does a calculation and checks using the digital signature if the details of the card are not tampered with, and the pass

The Aotearoa New Zealand COVID Pass allows you to easily and safely prove you can enter a large gathering. Simply tear or cut off the card on the right and carry it with you. You'll also need to carry a photo ID such as a driver licence or passport for the pass to be valid.

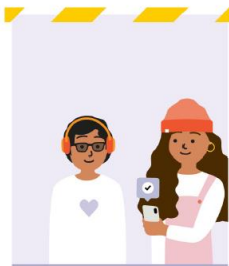

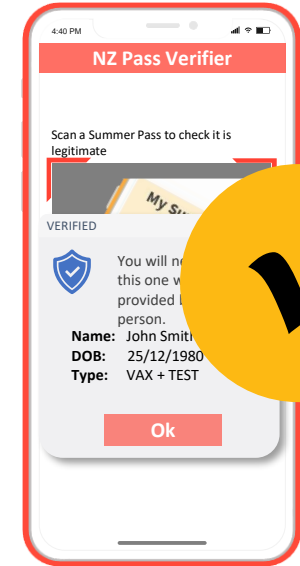
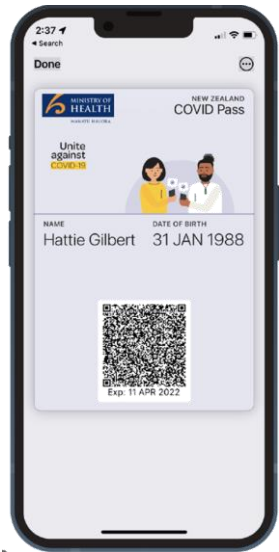
