Victoria University	Māori policy	<p><b>Te Ao Hurihuri/Issues in Contemporary Māori Society</b>  This course covers the development of government and iwi policy to address issues of significance to Māori. It includes a review of some traditional and contemporary tikanga and Māori concepts impacting on issues that governments wish to address through policy processes. The course also briefly covers Māori interest in international/Indigenous issues. Students will gain an insight into policy development processes as well as past and present mechanisms for dealing with Māori/iwi/hapū interest in policy outcomes.
