Community Matching Fund

What is the Community Matching Fund?

The Community Matching Fund is available to Western Bay community groups and organisations.

There is \$160,000 (\$100,000 general fund and \$60,000 environmental fund) available for community and environmental projects that make a positive difference in the District.

Grants are "matched" on a 50/50 basis with grants between \$1,000 to \$10,000 being the most common.

The community group contribution can be made up of any combination of volunteer labour, donated professional services, funds raised through other means and/or donations of materials.

Community Board Grants

What is the Community Board Grants Fund?

Community Boards consider applications for grants on an ad hoc basis throughout the year. Funds can range between **\$5,000 - \$10,000** (ward dependent).

Five Community Boards in the Western Bay of Plenty District

- Katikati Community Board
- Maketu Community Board
- Ōmokoroa Community Board
- Te Puke Community Board
- Waihī Beach Community Board

Applications must demonstrate that the activities/projects will result in a public benefit, primarily to residents of the relevant Community Board area.
